Education Cooperation**

The South Australian Department for Education and Child Development, International Education Services, offers a range of programs for international students in South Australian Government Schools. These programs include group study tour programs, intensive English programs, study abroad programs, primary and high school programs as well as customised teacher training programs.

This agreement establishes the relationship between Assumption College Thonburi and selected South Australian Government Schools, through the assistance of Aus-Connect.

In accordance with the proposal for cultural cooperation between the parties we acknowledge:

- the importance of educational cooperation
- the mutually beneficial outcomes of the professional relationship between the two parties
- the reciprocal commitment to further develop and deepen cooperation; and
- the importance of enhancing the exchange of international culture as a means of strengthening mutual understanding

International Education Services will:

- select South Australian Government Schools according to individual student and teacher needs from Assumption College Thonburi
- will assign Aus-Connect to provide ongoing support to Assumption College Thonburi

Aus-Connect will:

- support Assumption College Thonburi with regards to the following tasks:
 - counselling or giving advice to students and/or parents (e.g. if the school arranges Orientation Day (or Parents Meetings) and Pre-Departure Meetings)
 - completing and submitting student applications
 - assisting with obtaining visa and airfares

Assumption College Thonburi will:

- continue to send students and teachers to participate in programs offered in nominated South Australian Government Schools as negotiated
- continue to manage all matters relating to students studying in South Australian Government Schools through Aus-Connect

For 5 one year Study Abroad Program/High School Graduate Program students (whereby Study Abroad Program/High School Graduate Program students arrive at the same time)

- IES funds 2 weeks homestay for 1 accompanying teacher
- IES organises 2 weeks of professional development/teacher training in host South Australian Government schools for 1 accompanying teacher
- IES funds the tourist visa for 1 accompanying teacher

For 10 one year Study Abroad Program/High School Graduate Program students (whereby Study Abroad Program/High School Graduate Program students arrive at the same time)

- IES funds 2 weeks homestay for 1 accompanying teacher
- IES organises 2 weeks of professional development/teacher training in host South Australian Government schools for 1 accompanying teacher
- IES funds the tourist visa for 1 accompanying teacher
- IES funds the return airfare for 1 accompanying teacher


This agreement was signed in good faith and in a spirit of mutual interest and respect for a period of 3 (three) years
